

8. Transportation / Airport Pick-up

12. Site of The World Championships

Hwaseong City, Korea

Hwaseong City is located on the southwest coast of Gyeonggi Province, the Midwest region of the Korean Peninsula, and it borders with 7 cities on land, It borders by sea with the Port of Pyungtaek on the West Sea.

Climate of Hwaseong City

During the Championships period, usually it is between $21^{\circ}C \sim 23^{\circ}C$.
