



Bulletin 3. July 2015 – updated July 9th

PM Nordic ARDF Championship 2015

This document contains information of the competition as maps and other practical information.

Registration:

For the competition you can pay in cash NOK (preferred) or Euro. Registration at the hotel on Friday 7th from 12 o'clock.

Payment Hotel: Accommodation payment shall be direct to the hotel and HAM dinner to the restaurant per person.

Food and grocery: Several shops where food can be purchased in Lillehammer.

Clothing

The Sunday race is at relative high altitude (750m asl) and it recommended bringing warm clothing, as whenever you visit Norway.

EMIT electronic punching

Only EMIT EKT punching badges can be used. (Youth/beginner has mechanical punching only)

Model training Friday 7th August

A model track will be available after the sprint competition until 19:00.

Sprint and youth 2m Friday 7th August

The area around the event centre is used for sprint. **Note** that there is an embargo around the hotel. See the enclosed map in this document. Youth race starts from the finish.

Start at 16:00 outside hotel lobby.

Output power approximately 0.5W

Antenna Vertical 5m + 3 x 1.5m radial counterpoise

Technical info 2m youth

Frequency controls 1-3 144.600 MHz

Output power 3W -PEP

Antenna, crossed dipole 2m above ground

Note! Mechanical punching for youth 2m





2m Nordic Championship, Saturday 8th August

Transport by car to start from hotel at 12:45. Limited parking so co-driving is required. Youth race starts at finish area.

Frequency controls 1-5 144.600 MHz Frequency control beacon 144.750 kHz

Output power 3W - PEP

Antenna, crossed dipole 2m above ground

80m Youth

Frequency controls 1-3 3579 kHz

Output power 3W

Maps and embargoed areas


Sprint area around the event centre is embargoed area Friday 7th August from 12 o'clock until the sprint starts at 16.00.
