The Nordic ARDF Championship in 2015 took place in Lillehammer Norway, 7<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> of August. Lillehammer is a town of 27 000 inhabitants located about 2 hour drive north of Oslo, and is perhaps mostly known for the Olympic Championship in 1994 and for the TV series Lilly hammer that has its name from the same town.

The ARDF championship was located to this area because it has many orienteering maps with different types of terrain, from flat sprint maps in Lillehammer to rough terrain with wet marshes and dense vegetation without many tracks to follow.

This year we had 51 runners attending the competition, both from the Nordic countries as well as visitors from Russia and Germany.
